

Welcome to Early Discoveries Drop-in Care Program

We are so happy you chose us to help you with your drop-in care needs. We wanted to share some important information to help your family be prepared for your drop-in care day(s). Our hours of operation are 6:30 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. Below you will find a checklist of items that you should bring along with a tentative schedule for mealtimes. Each classroom has their own individualized classroom schedule with outdoor times and curriculum times. For more information, please visit our center website earlydiscoveriesil.com.

Supplies Needed - please label your child's items with their full name.

Extra change(s) of clothes, underwear, socks, shoes

Seasonal Outerwear: (Infants go out daily as their schedules allow, Toddlers – K-Prep go outside twice a day weather permitting):

- swimsuit, towel, sun hat
- jacket or coat
- snow pants, boots, gloves, hat, (please no scarves unless they are infinity scarves)
- Diapers, wipes, ointments (in tubes only) we must have a form on file
- Small cot blanket for toddlers, twos, preschool/k-prep
- Sleep sack for infants (We cannot use blankets in the cribs)

Comfort Items (if applicable):

• pacifier, stuffed toy, blanket, family photo

Rest times: Infants: according to their individual schedule, Toddlers/Young Preschool: 12:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. and Preschool/K-Prep: 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Menu: You can find our menu on our website earlydiscoveriesil.com - please note we do not allow outside food for Toddlers (15months) or older unless you have provided a Dr.'s Note.

Mealtimes: Breakfast 7:00 a.m. – 8 a.m., Second breakfast 8:30 a.m. – 9:30 a.m., Lunch Infants/Toddlers/Young Preschool: 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., Preschool/K-Prep 11:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Times may vary slightly depending on classroom schedules and outside times.

Please notify the center of any allergies that your child may have. You must provide us with life- saving medication on the days that your child is scheduled for drop-in care and an action plan/medical plan.

Infant Food: Table food is provided. If your child is new to trying table foods, we ask that they try it at home before trying it at the center. A tip to help with sharing what your child can have is to print the menu and highlight the items your child can have. For infants 1-year and older milk is provided. If your child is under 1-year and they drink milk, we would need to be provided with a Dr.'s note to serve them milk.

We ask that all bottles are a pre-mixed formula or breast milk (please be sure the breast milk is not frozen as we use bottle warmers to warm the bottles) Please note: If you are bringing in glass bottles, they must have a sleeve, or we are unable to use them.

Please label your child's bottles and jar food/cereal with their full name, number of ounces, and date.
